Requires MVC to check Social Security Administration records and mark deceased individuals in MVC database once per month.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. The Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle
8 Commission shall compare, not less than once per month, the
9 commission's database records with the death records produced by
10 the Social Security Administration and shall mark as deceased in
11 the commission's database records any individual who is listed in
12 those death records.

14 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

19 This bill requires the Chief Administrator of the New Jersey
20 Motor Vehicle Commission (commission) to compare, not less than
21 once per month, the commission's database records with the death
22 records produced by the Social Security Administration and mark as
23 deceased in the commission's database records any individual who
